

Community Group Questions What's Love Got To Do With It - Matthew 5:43-48

1. What stood out to you most from the Bible passage?

2. Why are we to love our enemies? Do people who cause us pain deserve our love and prayer? What does Jesus mean by loving our enemies?

3. What does it mean that love reveals our identity? Who or what are you tempted to find your identity in other than God?

4. Is there someone in your life that is making life harder for you that you're tempted to complain about, gossip about or even hate in your heart? Are you willing to plead for your enemies, and people who make life harder for you, in obedience to Christ's command?



Community Group Questions Salt & Light - Matthew 5:13-16

1. What stood out to you from this passage?

2. How did they think of salt and light 2,000 years ago when Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount? What are salt and light great metaphors to describe Christ-followers?

3. What does it mean that "there is no impact without contact"? Who in your life are you called to be salt and light to? Be specific.

4. What about being inadequate to change others hearts and minds makes us even more equipped to share our faith? Humility doesn't stop us from sharing our faith, but rather we're called to share our faith with humility. Why is humility important when we witness Christ to others?

5. How is sharing your faith like joining a conversation the Holy Spirit has already started with another person? What is the role of listening in sharing your faith with another person?.
